

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (10 Courses)

Gen Ed is arranged around four thematic clusters:

Numeracy and Scientific Literacy Values, Beliefs and Identity **Community and Society** Communication

Tier 1 - four courses - one from each cluster.

Tier 2 - three approved Gen Ed Tier 2 courses. One must be from Cluster 1.

Tier 3 - three approved Gen Ed Tier 3 courses from at least two different clusters.

Several courses can belong to more than one category. For example, Psyc 3369 Sensation and Perception can also fit under Biopsychology.
