Education Options for UofA Elementary

This is a list of recommended courses for students intending to pursue a Bachelor of Elementary Education at the **UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA**.

It is recommended that students transfer to UofA after **1 year (8-10 courses)**. To transfer into this program, students are required to have completed **English Language Arts 30-I. Math 30 Pure is strongly recommended**. It is the student's responsibility to use the Mount Royal Calendar to ensure they have all required pre-requisites. For detailed information go to:

Choose 8-10 courses from:

Language/Literature Element	Two English at the 1100 level
Mathematics Element	One of Math 1205 (recommended for students who have not completed Math 30) or any transferable Math course.
Social Science Element	One transferable Anthropology, Economics, History, Political Science or Sociology
Natural Science Element	One of Astronomy 2201, 2203, 2205, 2211, Biology 1204, 1205, 1202, Chemistry 1201, Geography 1101 or Geology 1101, Geography 1103, Geology 2209, Physics 1201, or 1211
Fine Arts Element	One of Art History 1101, 1103, 2207, 3309, 3313, 3315, English 1143, Theatre 1112, 1115, 1202, or 1203
Physical Education Element	PHED 2255 and 2257 (both courses are required to receive credit for one course at UofA)
Health Element	Psychology 3327 or Sociology 2271
Computing Requirement	One of EDUC 2325 (recommended), Computer Science 2215, or 2231
Education Core	Education 1231, 2321
Minor Courses	Up to three courses from chosen minor. See http://www.registrar.ualberta.ca/calendar/Undergrad/Education/chart1.html
Non-Education Options	Select up to five transferable courses (Courses related to the teaching Minor or additional courses from the Elements are recommended.)
Open Option	Three transferable courses including Education 2312
