Mount Royal University Cougars outside hitter Olivia Grecu had a big weekend versus Lakeland College, as the team swept the two-game series, 3-2 and 3-0.

On Friday night, Grecu put up one of the biggest performances of the season to date, racking up an astonishing 22 kills, along with a dig and a block as the Cougars downed the Rustlers 27-25, 26-28, 25-14, 18-25 and 15-8.

Grecu followed up her best match of the season with another strong performance Saturday, reaching double-digit kills (10), while also racking up seven digs, a block and two service aces.

The third-year left side out of Calgary is enrolled in the Bachelor of Communication program at MRU and ranks fourth in the league in kills per set, averaging 3.3.
