**Male - Nathan Schurr**



Mount Royal University men's golfer Nathan Schurr has done it again. After claiming last year's ACAC men's individual golf title with a two-day total of 147, Schurr bested himself in 2011, shaving three strokes off last year's total, firing a two-day score of 144 to win his second consecutive ACAC individual gold medal.

After firing an opening round 70, Schurr showed heart and determination in Monday's final round. Trailing by a shot through 15 holes to Grant MacEwan's Adam Bruce, Schurr posted birdies on the 16th and 18th holes to best Bruce by two strokes, becoming only the fourth repeat champion in ACAC men's golf since 1965-66 and first back-to-back champion since Scott Allan of SAIT won consecutive titles 1993-94.

Originally from Bragg Creek, Alberta, Schurr is in his fourth year in the Bachelor of Business Administration — Marketing program at MRU.
