C. Terms of Reference

1. Definition of Alumni

All Mount Royal University alumni are eligible for Legacy Awards.

Alumni are defined as persons:

- who have received degrees, diplomas, credit certificates, or high school diplomas from the University;
- who have received designated credit-free certificates in the following programs: Funeral Director Extension Certificate, Herbal Therapy Extension Certificate, Massage Therapy Extension Certificate, Personal Fitness Trainer Extension Certificate, TVP Employment Preparation Extension Certificate;
- who have successfully completed one full scholastic year (30 academic credits) of study at the University and one full year has passed since their last date of attendance; or
- who are 18 years of age or older and previously attended the Mount Royal University Conservatory for a minimum of 6 years.

2. Definition of Awards

a. Horizon Award

Recognizes the outstanding achievements of Mount Royal University alumni early in their careers. Nominees must have completed their studies at Mount Royal University no more than 10 years prior to the year for which they are nominated and must be under the age of 35.

b. Lifetime Distinguished Achievement Award

Recognizes alumni who have brought great honour to their alma mater and fellow alumni through sustained commitment to excellence in professional, community and/or personal endeavors.

c. Outstanding Alumni Awards (6 categories)

i. Academic Achievement

Recognizes profound activities in academic research, teaching, program development, and/or educational administration.

ii. Arts and Culture

Recognizes prominence and acclaim in the fine, performing, literary and/or applied arts.

iii. Athletic Achievement

Recognizes superlative performance in and/or service to professional or amateur sport.

iv. Community Service

Recognizes notable service and/or contributions to the welfare and advancement of local, national or international communities.

v. Professional Achievement

Recognizes exceptional achievement in the individual's professional career. Includes, but is not limited to: business, communications, social services, health care, and sciences.

vi. Service to the University

Recognizes professional or voluntary activities undertaken on behalf of Mount Royal University, the Alumni Association, or other organizations affiliated with the University.

3. Description of Awards

Each recipient will receive a framed certificate and/or commemorative item from the University and the Mount Royal University Alumni Association.
