TUITION FEE SCHEDULE

The Tuition fee tables for 2011/2012 are attached and provide an outline of the Board of Governors approved tuition fees for this Academic year.

Under the Government of Alberta's Tuition Fee Policy legislation and regulations, the University is required to publish an estimate of the subsequent three years tuition fee increases (2012/13 to 2014/15). The annual increase is limited to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Alberta. The Board of Governors has approved for planning/forecasting purposes an estimated CPI increase of 1.0% for 2012/13 and an estimated CPI increase of 2.0% per year for each of the subsequent academic years (2013/14 and 2014/15). Students can utilize these estimated annual increases to estimate future tuition. Actual increases each academic year will be approved annually by the Board of Governors consistent with the Government of Alberta's tuition fee policy legislation and regulations. These estimated annual increases are for planning purposes only.

A full course is the standard course at Mount Royal and has an Academic credit value of 3 academic credits. The full course fee also applies to other courses that have an Academic Credit value of between 2 and 5 Academic credits. The ½ course fee applies to courses with an Academic credit value between 1 and 2 Academic credits. The ¼ course fee applies to courses with an Academic credit value of 1 or less Academic credits. Courses with multiples of 3 Academic credits will be charged at the multiple level of the standard full course rate (i.e.: A course with an Academic credit value of 6 credits will have fees assessed at two times the full course fee, a course with an Academic credit value of 15 Academic credits will be charged at five times the full course fee).

Degree Program Non-credit work experience and Co-operative Education – non-credit work experience and non-credit co-operative education courses will be assessed a fee of \$482.30 per course. The non-credit work experience professional development course and the non-credit co-operative education preparation course will be assessed a fee of \$241.15 per course.

For 2012/13 and beyond all University Transfer and Applied Degree students will be assessed fees as per Fee Table 1.

1. The Students' Association Health & Dental Plan fees and Reflector fee will apply to Fall and Winter semesters only.
2. The Health and Dental Fee is charged to cover insurance premiums for the student health and dental plan. You may opt out of this fee if you have comparable insurance coverage through another source by visiting the Student Health Network office in Wyckham House during the first three weeks of the fall semester. You may activate your coverage by visiting the Student Health Network office in Wyckham House between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, during the school year. Both the opt-out and the activation forms are also available on-line for your convenience at samru.ca.
3. The Reflector Fee is collected by the Students' Association through an agreement with the Reflector – the autonomous student newspaper on campus.
4. The UPass fee for 2011/2012 is administered by the University through the Parking and Transportation office. Please consult the University's website for the most up to date information on the UPass program.
