TUITION FEE SCHEDULE

Amended June 1, 2008

The Tuition fee tables for 2008/2009 are attached and provide an outline of the Board of Governors approved tuition fees for this Academic year.

Under the Government of Alberta's Tuition Fee Policy legislation and regulations, the College is required to publish an estimate of the subsequent three years tuition fee increases (2009/10 to 2011/12). The Board of Governors has approved for planning/forecasting purposes an estimated increase of 4.0% per year for the following three academic years. Students can utilize the 4.0% annual increase to estimate future tuition. Actual increases each academic year will be approved annually by the Board of Governors consistent with the Government of Alberta's tuition fee policy legislation and regulations. The 4.0% estimated annual increase is for planning purposes only.

A full course is the standard course at Mount Royal and has an Academic credit value of 3 academic credits. The full course fee also applies to other courses that have an Academic Credit value of between 2 and 5 Academic credits. The ½ course fee applies to courses with an Academic credit value between 1 and 2 Academic credits. The ¼ course fee applies to courses with an Academic credit value of 1 or less Academic credits. Courses with multiples of 3 Academic credits will be charged at the multiple level of the standard full course rate (i.e.: A course with an Academic value of 6 credits will have fees assessed at two times the full course fee, a course with an Academic credit value of 15 Academic credits will be charged at five times the full course fee).

Bachelor Degree Programs for Fall 2008 – The new Mount Royal College (MRC) Bachelor Degree programs in Arts, Science, Business, Communications and Arts-Criminal Justice have been approved by Advanced Education and Technology for implementation commencing in the Fall of 2008. As well, the College will continue to offer the Bachelor of Nursing Degree program. The Board of Governors has approved a supplemental per full course program fee of \$80 per full course for all students enrolled in any of MRC's Bachelor's degree programs. The fee is assessed per course based upon the actual number of courses the Bachelor's degree student is enrolled in. This fee is a supplemental fee over and above the base per course tuition fees as outlined in the tuition fee tables attached.

The Co-operative Education fee of \$496.85 for 2008/09 has also been approved by the Board of Governors.

4. The Reflector Fee is collected by the Students' Association through an agreement with the Reflector – the autonomous student newspaper on campus.
