

# HOW TO USE THE ALBERTA TRANSFER GUIDE

**Search the Online Alberta Transfer Guide**



There are two ways of searching the Transfer Guide.

**Fast Find** assumes you have the Mount Royal College Calendar or the University Calendar in front of you and you only want to search one course at a time.

**Step-By-Step** walks you through the search process if you don't have a transcript or calendar in front of you; or, if you want to search for multiple courses or programs at a time.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** You **MUST** type the course name in it's abbreviated form as seen in the Calendar at Mount Royal. If you type out the word: ENGLISH 2231 your search will come back as **"No agreement found."**

## UNDER FAST FIND:

The **TO institution** search allows you to plug in the required courses offered by your university and see what the equivalents (if any) are at Mount Royal College. You will need the University Calendar in front of you for this search.

The **FROM institution** search allows you to see if your option courses transfer from Mount Royal College to the university you plan to transfer to. You will need the Mount Royal College Calendar in front of you for this search.
