

Mandate – Mount Royal University

This mandate has been developed pursuant to Section 78 of the *Post-secondary Learning Act* (PSLA).

Below are the role and functions of Mount Royal University (the University), as articulated under legislation and policy.

1. Institution-Type	The University is a public post-secondary institution operating in Alberta as an undergraduate university under the PSLA.
2. Credentials and Programming	<p>The University must provide undergraduate degree programs.</p> <p>The University shall not provide graduate-level programs.</p> <p>The University may provide approved foundational learning, diploma or certificate programs and other undergraduate-level credentials listed in Part 1A of the Alberta Credential Framework.</p>
3. Collaboration	The University must collaborate with other post-secondary institutions to support regional access to undergraduate degree programs
4. Research and Scholarly Activities	The University may undertake research and scholarly activities that enrich undergraduate education.
5. Geographic Service Area	The University operates primarily in the Calgary region in terms of program delivery.
