#### PRIORITIZED SUMMARY OF PROJECTED ACTIVITIES AND OUTCOMES

Review and Approval of Updated Research Policies - Responsible Conduct in Research Policy and related procedures moved to 30 day community consultation until November 2, 2022. Final drafts will be presented to RSC on November 15 for recommendation to GFC and approval by GFC at the November 25 meeting. The Institutes Policy and HREB policies will subsequently be brought to RSC for review.

Planning and Execution of Annual Research and Scholarship Days circa April 2023 including Research and Recognition Awards.

Research Data Management Plan Development - The RSC working group will address the issue of a Research Data Management Plan with consideration of Tri-Agency guidelines and recommendations and a deadline of March 1, 2023.

Finalization of International Research Document - The document developed by the working group last year will be finalized and it will be determined where this information will reside.

Undergraduate Research and Scholarship Plan Continuation - Finalization of work started by last year's working group to develop an Undergraduate Research and Scholarship designation for students.

Indigenous Research consideration with dr. linda manyguns - where are we and where do we need to go?

High level consideration of next Strategic Research and Scholarship Plan (2023-2028)

Monthly updates on research, scholarship and community engagement activities and new or revised Tri-Agency directives. Also, monthly sharing of Good News research and scholarship activities.
