**4. Establish Working Groups for 2025-26**

The following working groups were reviewed and confirmed. RSC members were encouraged to join at least one working group for this academic year, and to have their first meeting by the next RSC meeting (November 19). An overview of the focus for each group was provided:

- **Research Impact (including community engagement, DORA, IP and Commercialization)**  
Topics: We've signed on to DORA - now what? Both the IP and Commercialization policies need to be updated this year - this group will review changes and provide input. Does the group have thoughts regarding community engagement more broadly?
- **Research Data Management (including Research Security)**  
Topics: Execute on the recommendations of 2024-25 Final Report. Brainstorm training for Open Access including predatory journals etc. Consider implications of Research Security for data management and beyond. Revisit the Research Data Management Strategy for Actions needed.
- **Research and Scholarship Days**  
Topics: The main focus of this group is to plan and execute on Research and Scholarship Days in early April 2026. This event keeps growing so scale and budget will need to be considered. A new approach was taken last year - are changes needed this year? ORSCE Administrative Assistant Rabia Haider will provide logistics and planning support and Scott Corner from Marketing and Communications provides vital direction.
- **Undergraduate Research (UGR) and Scholarship**  
Topics: Execute on the recommendations of the 2024-25 Final Report which focus on the survey results from last year. Provide input into a plan for centralized UGR resources. Consider best practices for job postings and implications of the new Mount Royal Staff Association Collective Agreement's inclusion of RAs. Note: Undergraduate Research Dissemination Fund (URDF) Review Committee has been struck for reviewing MRU student applications for funding: Melissa Deane, Reza Chowdhury, Brian Jackson, Zenith Bose.
- **AI in Research**  
Topics: This is a new Working Group that will focus on AI implications for Research. Some resources are currently provided on the Research website. In addition, a University AI Framework and associated Steering Committee is being created and last year an AI in Teaching and Learning Committee was struck. What more can be done at MRU regarding AI and Research?
