

Funding your Education – Loans, Grants, Scholarships

Loans and Grants - Information and tips to help you apply for Canada Student Loans (CSL) and Grants

- The Canada Student Grant for Students with Disabilities (CSGD) is an annual **federal** needs-based grant. This means you need to apply for CSL and **be eligible for at least \$1.00** of financial need every academic year (Sept 1 - Aug 31) that you want to apply for the CSGD.
- To apply for this grant, your Access Advisor in conjunction with the Access Supports Coordinator or Assistive Technology Advisor will complete an application called a Schedule 4. Your disability documentation will be submitted to Alberta Student Aid (ASA) alongside the Schedule 4 to identify you as a student with a permanent, persistent, or prolonged disability.
- **Full-Time students:** When completing the full-time loan application online at [Alberta Student Aid](#) (ASA) you need to enter your actual costs for tuition, fees, books, and supplies and enter \$500.00 for computer cost. These costs are there in the online application, **copy and paste the costs into the relevant boxes.** *See Appendix E*
 - If you are living with your parents, they will need to complete a Schedule 1 form. **You must check "yes"** for the question "I wish to be considered for **federal** grants and loans and the Alberta Low Income Grant". If you do not check "yes", you will not be assessed for federal loans and grants and will not be eligible for the Canada Student Grant for Students with Disabilities or any other Federal grants. **This is one area where you will be unable to do an edit to your application.** *See Appendix A.*
 - If you do not want, or financially need any loan money, enter \$1.00 on the very last line of the application which states "Total Amount of Assistance Requested". Entering \$1.00 indicates to the assessors that you want to be assessed for grants and that you do not want any loans. This is the **only** place you enter \$1.00. *See appendix F*
- **Part-Time students:** If you are completing a part-time (PT) CSL application you will need to use the application found at [Alberta Student Aid](#). You need to print it and complete the application **except page 3 section 5** which is to be completed by the MRU Office of the Registrar and Financial Aid staff located in A101.
 - MRU Registration and Financial Aid will email your PT application back to you
 - You need to upload the application to your Alberta Student Aid account - use the below link found on your Alberta Student Aid account to upload your application.



If you have any issues with uploading your application contact MRU Registration and Financial Aid, as well as the Access Coordinator as soon as possible. MRU Registration and Financial Aid staff may email your application to ASA for you.

- If you **do not want or need any loan money**, in section 6 where you are asked "Do you want to be considered for a part-time Canada Student Loan" **check the "No" box**. In section 6A leave the box blank or enter \$1.00 on the application where it states "Total Amount of Assistance Requested". Also, in section 6 check "yes" to the question "Are you a student with a permanent disability?" *See appendix B.* Take or email the completed Part-time application to MRU Registration and Financial Aid staff so that they can complete the institution portion.

- **When you have delivered/mailed your part-time application to MRU Registration and Financial Aid for processing, let your Access Advisor and/or the Access Supports Coordinator know so that a Schedule 4 can be submitted to ASA on your behalf.**
- **All Students:** If you are eligible for grants and/or loans, you will need to complete the Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement forms (MSFAA) provided by Alberta Student Aid (ASA) in order to receive funds. You will receive notification from ASA to complete these forms online and provide banking information to facilitate the deposit. **Do this as soon as possible** once you receive notification from ASA. *See appendix C.*
- **Other grants you may be eligible for depending on your financial and academic situation:**
 - Canada Student Grant for Full Time Students
 - Canada Student Grant for Part Time Students
 - Canada Student Grant for Full Time Students with Dependents
 - Skill Boost Top-up to the Canada Student Grant for Full Time Students
 - Alberta Student Grant for Full Time Students
 - Alberta Student Grant for Part Time Students
 - Alberta Student Grant for Part Time Students with Dependents
- You have 24/7 access to your ASA account; Access Advisors have no access and the Assistive Technology Advisors and the Access Supports Coordinator have limited access.
- The loan and grant application process will take some time, it is best to start early in the academic year. Schedule 4 applications can take 4-6 weeks to be processed.

Belcourt-Brosseau Métis Award

The Belcourt-Brosseau Métis Awards Fund was established to help Métis Albertans realize self-sufficiency through post-secondary education and skills development.

Valued between \$2,000 and \$10,000, this award is intended to cover a portion of education related costs such as tuition and fees.

The award is open to Alberta Métis citizens, and priority is given to students entering their first year of post-secondary education. Students must show financial need and have a connection to the Métis community.
