## Student Loan & Canada Student Grant: Application Checklist

**Go online to Alberta Student Aid <u>www.studentaid.alberta.ca</u>** (there is also a link to Alberta Student Aid from the Accessibility Services webpage: Quick Links section).

- 1. Prior to each part time semester go online to Alberta Student Aid and print the Part Time application
  - a. Complete the application and identify yourself as a student with a disability
  - b. If you want services or technology and your documentation supports this, you must complete a Schedule 4 form for each part time semester see box below.
- 2. Take the Part Time application form to MRU Student Awards and Financial Aid (A101) office and they will complete relevant sections and submit to Alberta Student Aid via government courier. This applies during COVID 19.
