

Program Session Dates







- · Your repayment obligations
- · How your monthly payments will be calculated

Before you can receive your funding, you must sign your agreement(s), listed below.

Funding will be released when:

- · You have submitted all required documents
- · Your school confirms your registration
- · Classes begin
