It is highly recommended that students follow the order of the course offerings, specifically the CYCC Major and CHST courses on these guidelines. Our CYCC & CHST courses are offered once a year.

Students are encouraged to fit their General Education requirements and Electives where they can within their schedule. In total, students registered in the Bachelor of Child Studies- Child and Youth Care Counsellor are required to take 10 General Education and 4 Elective courses as part of their degree.

Full-time student status is considered 9 credits or 3 courses at 3 credits each. A full course load is 5 courses per semester (Fall and Winter). This would include your core CYCC or CHST and General Education or Elective courses.
