

## ADVISING WORKSHEET

Please use this BCST-ELCC Advising Worksheet in conjunction with GNED Worksheet, MRUGradU8, the Academic Calendar, and MyMRU. All MRU course descriptions are available in the [MRU Academic Calendar](#). It is highly recommended that students follow the order of the course offerings, specifically the ELCC Major and CHST courses on these guidelines. Our ELCC & CHST courses are offered once a year.

**Students are encouraged to fit their General Education requirements and Electives where they can within their schedule. In total, students registered in the Bachelor of Child Studies- Early Learning and Child Care are required to take 10 General Education and 5 Elective courses as part of their degree.**

**Full-time student status is considered 9 credits or 3 courses at 3 credits each. A full course load is 5 courses per semester (Fall and Winter). This would include your core ELCC or CHST and General Education or Elective courses.**
