A legacy of vision and innovation

Since opening its doors to students in 1911, Mount Royal University has provided innovative programs that prepare graduates to pursue further education and achieve success in their chosen fields. In the 1911/12 academic year, there were 179 students. Today, Mount Royal registers more than 13,000 full- and part-time credit students, and records over 50,000 continuing education course registrations, each year. Mount Royal offers more than 50 degree, applied degree, diploma and certificate programs in arts, business, communications, health and community studies, science and technology, teaching and learning, and continuing education.

Mount Royal College established

Prominent Calgarian and Methodist Minister, Rev. Dr. George W. Kerby, founded Mount Royal College in 1910. Kerby believed that an educated populace was the key to creating a civilized, enterprising and prosperous society, and Mount Royal retains his vision to this day.

In 1931, Mount Royal became the first educational institution in the province to offer university arts and science transfer courses as part of its affiliation with the University of Alberta. This partnership was the first in a series of transfer agreements between Mount Royal and several universities across Canada.

Mount Royal prepares workers for post-war boom

In the years following the Second World War, returning veterans filled Mount Royal's classrooms as they prepared for careers in Alberta's newly established oil industry and rapidly industrializing economy.

Mount Royal's second president, Rev. Dr. John Garden, recognized the workforce needed a place where people could continually upgrade their skills to meet the changing needs of industry. He established Mount Royal's first continuing education courses in 1947 to enable working professionals to learn new skills. Continuing education courses remain a distinguishing feature of Mount Royal's identity.

Growth creates need for new campus

During the 1950s and 1960s, Mount Royal continued to meet the growing needs of the community. By the late 1960s, Mount Royal had outgrown its original campus located at Seventh Avenue and 11 Street SW. Former Mount Royal President, Dr. Walter B. Pentz, led the search for a new campus. An abandoned airbase in the city's southwest was selected, and the Lincoln Park campus opened in 1972.

During the 1980s, the Alberta economy suffered a recession and Mount Royal faced its toughest economic conditions since the Great Depression. Despite the challenges, Mount Royal managed to meet the demand for more post-secondary spaces. A number of satellite campuses were established in the downtown core. The Lincoln Park facilities were expanded and a residence complex was constructed, first to house media during the 1988 Winter Olympics, then to house students.

Applied degree programs created

Mount Royal redefined its role again during the mid-1990s, when it introduced applied baccalaureate degrees in many areas, including communications, business administration, computer information systems and interior design.

21st century growth

The first years of the new century saw the addition of the East A and East B buildings to house the Faculty of Arts, the Bissett School of Business, International Education and the Languages Institute. The West residence buildings, opened in 2003, doubled the number of on-campus rooms available to students.

In 2006, Mount Royal opened the Centre for Continuous Learning. Later renamed the Roderick Mah Centre for Continuous Learning (RMCCL), the building received a gold certification for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) in recognition of its energy saving technologies. In 2011, expansion of both the RMCCL and the Arts and Science & Technology wing were completed. That same year, Mount Royal University broke ground for the construction of a new Conservatory building and the Bella Concert Hall.

University degree programs offered

In March 2007, Mount Royal announced its first baccalaureate degree — a Bachelor of Nursing. Mount Royal continued to expand its bachelor's degrees with the addition of five new programs in 2008: Bachelor of Arts; Bachelor of Arts — Criminal Justice; Bachelor of Business Administration; Bachelor of Communication; and Bachelor of Science. In 2009, Mount Royal launched the Bachelor of Computer Information Systems and, in 2011, the Bachelor of Education — Elementary and the Bachelor of Midwifery. Most recently, in early 2014, Mount Royal launched its tenth and eleventh baccalaureate degrees — the Bachelor of Health and Physical Education and the Bachelor of Child Studies.

Mount Royal University — A world of possibilities

On Sept. 3, 2009, the Government of Alberta changed Mount Royal's name from Mount Royal College to Mount Royal University. This name better reflects what Mount Royal has become — and what it does — by continuing to build on its rich legacy of teaching excellence with a dedication to becoming Canada's premier undergraduate university based on important measures of student success and satisfaction. That same year, Mount Royal became a member of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada and, in Fall 2012, joined the ranks of Canadian Interuniversity Sport.

Making history

On Aug. 15, 2010, Mount Royal University kicked-off its 16-month centennial celebration in honour of its 100-year legacy. As part of the centennial, the first comprehensive history of Mount Royal, *Catch the Gleam, Mount Royal from College to University, 1910—2009*, was written by Donald Noel Baker, PhD. Baker was President of Mount Royal College from 1980 to 1989. On Nov. 4, 2011, the University proudly unveiled its official Coat of Arms at the installation of Mount Royal's ninth president, David Docherty, PhD.

As Ryan Johnson walks down the stairs of the Convocation stage, he leaves with more than just an education and a Bachelor of Arts — Criminal Justice parchment; he also leaves with a new take on family, friends and how to best impact the lives of those around him.

Looking forward to his career as a police officer, Johnson plans on taking the sense of citizenship he built at Mount Royal with him to strengthen communities wherever he ends up.

As a Resident Advisor (RA) for several years, building and supporting communities is nothing new for this student leader.

"Becoming an RA was one of the best experiences," says Johnson. "I got to meet and really get to know a lot of like-minded people and help support my peers when they really just needed someone to talk to."

Always eager to lend a hand, volunteering and landing a subsequent internship with the Calgary Police Services' Victim Assistance Unit is further proof of the caring nature of this Valedictorian.

On campus, Johnson's strong values and keen interest in supporting fellow students led him to volunteer for Mount Royal's Academic Misconduct Board and to work with Security Services to support the safety of the campus community as part of his RA duties. He also involved himself with Accessibility Services by taking notes for a fellow student with a disability.

"My experience here has been far more than I could have ever hoped for — it's definitely been more than an education," says Johnson. "And that is the true value that you get from Mount Royal."

As Johnson prepares to extend his commitment to growing social capital, his reluctance to leave the community he has called home for the last several years is only overshadowed by his excitement to become a leader in a new community.

"Learning takes place in the least expected ways," says Johnson. "And I'm excited to take all of the lessons I have learned and represent Mount Royal as an ambassador in the community."

Being part of Mount Royal's lifeblood inspired Johnson's success. With an impressive 3.96 GPA, Johnson has also been selected as the Centennial Medal recipient for 2014.

Centennial Medal Color

The 2014 recipient of the Centennial Medal Ryan Jon Johnson, Bachelor of Arts — Criminal Justice

The 2014 Centennial Medal is awarded to Ryan Johnson, who is graduating from the Bachelor of Arts — Criminal Justice program. Johnson has demonstrated both academic excellence and leadership in his various roles on campus and in the community.

During his time at Mount Royal, Johnson took on many leadership and volunteer roles — both on and off campus. As a Resident Advisor he supported his fellow students and assisted the University through participation on various boards and advisory committees.

With a strong commitment to his community, Johnson annually captains a team in the Relay for Life Race in Airdrie.

Given to one Valedictorian each year, the Centennial Medal is patterned after the Henry Birks and Sons Gold Medal, which was Mount Royal's highest award for student academic achievement from 1935 to 1985.

The Centennial Medal commemorates a deep tradition of student academic achievement and leadership at Mount Royal. The medal is embossed with the Mount Royal badge on one side, and the date surrounded by a crescent of wheat sheaves on the other.

Danielle Jacqueline Elizabeth Gariepy Valedictorian

Some things just run in the family, and as Danielle (Dani) Gariepy's mother watches her daughter cross the stage today with a Bachelor of Nursing, she will not only be proud of her university graduate, but of her soon-to-be colleague.

Looking beyond the traditional take on a nursing career, it's Gariepy's interest in global health inequities that she hopes will lead her to a career in community development outside of the usual nursing paradigm.

Always focused on taking the most from her experiences, Gariepy became well ingrained in the campus community working as a Resident Advisor (RA), a Residence Community Advisor, a Recreation employee, and through participation in community projects, including a symposium on dating violence.

"While living in Residence I was approached and asked to be an RA. For me, that was very special," says Gariepy. "So, over the four years I lived on campus, I really made it my home — the friends that I made in my very first year will be my friends forever."

As president of the Mount Royal Womens' Ringette Club for two years and as an avid player, Gariepy was able to represent Mount Royal twice on a national stage.

Taking a year hiatus from her studies to be a Stampede Princess for the Calgary Stampede's centennial celebration, Gariepy had the unique opportunity to be an ambassador for her city, but leaving her home on campus made her realize how much Mount Royal life meant to her.

"I really felt like the community took me in," says Gariepy. "And, in leaving I felt sad, but I had no doubt that I would be back, and I'm just thankful for the support I received that allowed me to go and have those amazing experiences."

That support she received from the campus community was what she credits for helping her persevere through moments of doubt during the academically rigorous Nursing program.

"Every test was a challenge," she says. "And, I often doubted myself, but the support of Mount Royal faculty helped to ensure that I overcame those challenges."

From someone who worked, learned, lived and played on campus, Gariepy says she will miss the community but looks forward to entering the workforce with her peers as an ambassador for the University.

"Take your piece of blue with you wherever you go. Take what you have learned during your time here and build it into your own community."



Leadership is nothing new to Evan Hudson. It's something she takes with her both onto the courts and into the classroom.

Hudson has earned a Bachelor of Business Administration — Accounting degree, and is ready to start her career in the fall at a top accounting firm.

Hudson embodies the spirit of Cougar Athletics, and from the day she was recruited to play on the women's basketball team from her high school team in Ponoka, she knew Mount Royal was where she wanted to live, learn and play.

"I came for basketball, but stayed for school," says Hudson, a two-time womens' basketball team captain, who admits she wasn't always the strongest player on the team, but always pushed her teammates to be their best academically and athletically.

As an active volunteer through Cougar Athletics, Hudson engaged with youth and applied her skills as a mentor. She was also a volunteer for the Athletic Student Advisory Board and earned a National Scholar Award from the Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) in recognition of her outstanding academic accomplishments as a CCAA student athlete.

Hudson says her experience at Mount Royal helped build the self-confidence and mental-toughness that she looks forward to carrying into her career.

"University brings out the strengths in people that will enable them to overcome barriers and really make a difference," says Hudson. "The lessons we've learned here will benefit us in our futures tenfold."

True to her athletic spirit, Hudson is quick to credit the team that has helped her succeed at Mount Royal — her family, faculty members and peers.

"My family has been my rock. My mom, my dad and my brother — without them, I wouldn't be here today," says Hudson. "They have all made me extremely proud to wear my last name on the back of my jersey, while my teammates make me proud to wear our logo on the front."

As a graduate, Hudson looks forward to the opportunities her new education will provide, and describes her time at Mount Royal as a well-balanced experience that she wouldn't have received at another University. She admits if she could do it all again, she would go back in a second.

"I am so honoured to have been selected as Valedictorian. I never imagined it possible and this is my proudest moment to date."

Ken King Bachelor of Health and Physical Education

Ken King is a name familiar to Calgarians for a number of reasons. Most know him as the President and CEO of the National Hockey League's (NHL) Calgary Flames, a position he has redefined several times since taking the role in 2001. He is also the Alternate Governor of the NHL and has leadership roles with the Calgary Hitmen, Calgary Roughnecks and Calgary Stampeders.


King's community involvement includes his current role as President of the Flames Foundation and other leadership roles with several charity fundraising initiatives emphasizing assistance to those in our community who are most in need.

"My personal joy comes from the happy obligation we all have to give back to our community and the wonderful sense of purpose and education we get in return. Nothing in life is easy and it takes consensus and teamwork to accomplish important goals," King says.

With a unique approach to business and partnerships, King first became known in Calgary in a big way during the 1990s as president and publisher of both the *Calgary Sun* and *Calgary Herald*. His career in the newspaper business spans 30 years and includes several senior executive positions with Canada's leading publications.

As a recipient of the Alberta Centennial Medal and the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal for Community Service, King extends his community involvement far beyond the confines of the Calgary Saddledome. He is chairman of the TELUS Community Board, past co-chair of REACH, a member of the RESOLVE Campaign (Calgarians Committed to Change), the Calgary Sport Tourism Authority Board, the Calgary Exhibition & Stampede, the Borden Ladner Gervais CIAU Athlete of the Year Awards Committee and a member of the Rotary Club of Calgary.

Because of his unfailing optimism, generosity towards others and loyalty to Calgary and Alberta, Mount Royal University's Board of Governors has chosen King to receive a 2014 Honorary Degree, the first Bachelor of Health and Physical Education degree awarded at the University.



With numerous awards to his name, Hal Wyatt has been an integral member of several influential municipal, provincial and national organizations throughout his life. Since beginning his exalted career at the Royal Bank of Canada (RBC) in Eyebrow, Saskatchewan, Wyatt has displayed a true dedication to neighbourhood involvement and volunteerism.

"I feel very strongly that we have to help one another — that graduates have each benefitted from the fact that their teachers, professors, lecturers and staff have been so dedicated to them," says Wyatt.

Always believing in being responsible to one another, Wyatt served in the Second World War, choosing the Royal Canadian Air Force, becoming a pilot and instructor, and returning to Canada as a Flight Lieutenant.

In 1986, Wyatt retired as Vice-Chairman and Director of RBC and began his new life as a local volunteer and philanthropist. His influence on Mount Royal has been vast. He served as inaugural chair of the Mount Royal College Foundation and is Chair Emeritus and Member of the Board of Directors today. The Mount Royal Conservatory's Wyatt Artist in Residence Series honours Wyatt and his wife Marnie — both fierce supporters of the arts.

Wyatt's long list of awards includes the Queen's Silver Jubilee, the Outstanding Canadian Award, and the Mount Royal College Distinguished Citizen Award. He is also a member of the Order of Canada and the Alberta Order of Excellence.

Wyatt's passion for enriching the lives of everyone around him makes him an ideal recipient of an honorary degree from Mount Royal.

"I've been particularly appreciative of the wonderful things that Mount Royal has done for so many years and to have them honour me is a special gift," says Wyatt.

Academic Awards ways

Governor General's Academic Medals

The Governor General's Medal, established in 1873, is one of the most prestigious awards that can be earned by a student in a Canadian educational institution for exceptional academic achievement. On behalf of His Excellency the Right Honourable David Johnston, Governor General of Canada, Mount Royal University is pleased to congratulate Veronica Grayce Van Horne and Justine Mae Palinkas for their outstanding academic achievements.

Bronze Medal

Veronica Grayce Van Horne is the 2014 Bronze Medal recipient and is graduating with a Social Work Diploma. Van Horne earned the highest GPA of all graduates of Mount Royal diploma programs for 2014 with a GPA of 3.98.

Silver Medal

Justine Mae Palinkas is the 2014 Silver Medal recipient and is graduating with a Bachelor of Applied Child Studies. Palinkas earned the highest GPA of all graduates of Mount Royal bachelor's degree programs for 2014 with a GPA of 4.00.



Diana Patterson has been selected by Mount Royal University's Board of Governors as Professor Emerita for her ongoing commitment to, and affinity with, the University.

Patterson retired in 2013 after dedicating 22 years of her career to teaching in the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Communication Studies at Mount Royal.

Patterson's dedication to her students, colleagues and co-workers across the institution is revered and has been instrumental in helping to build Mount Royal's reputation and preserving its traditions.

Well known around campus as the Harry Potter specialist, Patterson has published several papers, as well as edited a book of academic essays on the Harry Potter series and its resulting literary phenomenon.

Patterson's passion for history has played a considerable role in developing additions to the Mount Royal Archives, and she has helped to start a collection of manuscripts pertaining to History, English and the Conservatory. As Professor Emerita, Patterson will surely contribute to keeping the rich history and traditions of Mount Royal alive.

As part of her Mount Royal legacy, Patterson was instrumental as acting chair of the Technical Writing program during the development of the Technical Communication Degree. She was the first to teach technical writing courses for first-year engineering students and also taught technical communications and electronic publishing in the Faculty of Communication Studies.

"I'm chuffed to bits about being selected as Professor Emerita, and excited to continue to support the Archives that catalogue the history of Mount Royal," says Patterson.

Patterson has been an invaluable resource to Mount Royal, and she will continue to enhance the reputation of the University as Professor Emerita. In the years to come, her ongoing knowledge and support will serve to guide, mentor and direct new faculty and students as Mount Royal strives to become Canada's premier undergraduate university.



Lee Wertzler has been selected by Mount Royal University's Board of Governors as Professor Emerita for her ongoing commitment to, and affinity with, the University.

Wertzler retired in 2013, after dedicating more than 30 years of her career to teaching in the Faculty of Arts at Mount Royal.

Instrumental to helping build Mount Royal's reputation, Wertzler's dedication to her students, colleagues and fellow faculty members across the institution is renowned.

Wertzler's keen interest in the process of learning has inspired her contributions to her faculty and across the University. Her enthusiasm for student success and commitment to making a lasting difference at Mount Royal is well-known amongst colleagues.

During her time at Mount Royal, Wertzler chaired the Behavioral Science Department and later the Psychology Department. In 2010, Wertzler was selected by the Institute for Scholarship of Teaching and Learning as a Nexen Scholar, a program that supports faculty committed to systematic scholarly inquiry into student learning.
