Applicants who successfully complete IB courses with a minimum grade of '4' may use applicable IB courses for the purpose of admission and transfer credit. Where an applicant presents both the IB course and the corresponding Grade 12 course, the higher grade will be used.

Score = Grade: if used as a high school course equivalent

7 = 97% – May be used to satisfy high school Group A, B, or C course and university level coursework

6 = 90% – May be used to satisfy high school Group A, B, or C course and university level coursework

5 = 82% – May be used to satisfy high school Group A, B, or C course and university level coursework

4 = 73% – May be used to satisfy high school Group A, B, or C course and university level coursework

3 = 60% – May be used as a high school equivalent only – Group A, B or C
