4. Continuing MRU student in good academic standing
5. Informed about campus services and ideally involved in varying extracurricular activities
6. Enthusiasm to work with fellow students and a strong desire to help them succeed
7. Commitment to the MRU community

## **APPLICATION PROCESS/TIMELINE**
