RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Have a presence in the office (C201J) for a few hours a week
2. Help plan/facilitate interfaith dialogue once a week during the semester
3. Create and assist with office programming (My Story, UN Interfaith Harmony Week, service projects, etc)

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. A time commitment of 2-3 hours a week
2. Attendance at training sessions throughout the year about the role and importance of interfaith and pluralism at MRU
3. Participation in an all campus Student Leadership conference
4. A MRU faculty/staff mentor to coach the student's spiritual development
5. Opportunity for Intercultural competence training (Intercultural Development Inventory)

2. Work with other peer leaders to build community and develop a sense of belonging on campus
3. Connect with Interfaith and religious leaders through the Calgary Interfaith Council
4. Eligible for small financial honorarium
