RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Plan and execute a week-long camp for approximately 30 high school students
2. Take part in the recruitment and selection of camp participants
3. Build relationships with different nations during recruitment efforts

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Training - First-Aid, Mental Health and Suicide Training.
2. GPA - Full-time students that are in good academic standing and returning to full-time studies in the fall semester
3. Time commitment - 35 hours per week from May 1st through August 15th. The camp

BENEFITS

1. Swag - MRU hoodies, water bottles and MEG backpacks filled with school supplies.
2. Certification - No formal certification is granted.
3. Access to shared office etc. - Student coordinators have their own office throughout the duration of their employment along with a camp cell phone and email.
4. Financial awards/compensation - \$18.00 per hour

APPLICATION PROCESS/TIMELINE

The job posting is released in February and interviews are scheduled at the beginning of March. Students apply by submitting a resume to the Aboriginal Science and Technology Education Program Administrator and are interviewed by a team of Iniskim Centre staff. Students are notified within 2 days of the final interview which is scheduled no later than March 15th and their positions begin in the first week of May.
