#### **STEPPING UP FACILITATORS**

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Peer facilitators are responsible for designing and implementing engaging and informative workshops based on the four Stepping Up modules: Gender & Media, Healthy Relationships, Sexual Relationships, and Bystander Intervention.
- 2. Work with the Stepping Up coordinator and the faculty/research team when creating the workshops.
- 3. Receive support by the project coordinator and a team of community partner volunteers during each workshop.

### **QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Interview in September
- 2. Three development weekends (totaling 5 days) throughout the fall semester
- 3. Main Stepping Up weekend (totaling 1.5 days) in January

### **BENEFITS**:

- Peer facilitators who remain committed to the Stepping Up project in its entirety for the academic year receive an honorarium of approximately \$450 in January, after the final Stepping Up weekend concludes.
- 2. Peer facilitators receive several different Stepping up "swag" items as well as several different trainings, including responding to disclosures of sexual assault and how to facilitate a group.
