CHOOSE YOUR COURSES

This program has been designed to be taken over two years, but can be completed in up to six years.

TIPS

• To maintain full-time status, you must register for a minimum of 60% of a full course load. The course load per semester is based on the total semester hours. Specific course hours and the total hours for each semester is located in the course list.

Exceptions apply, so we recommend connecting with MRU Financial Aid for guidance.

- The minimum grade required to meet prerequisite and graduation requirements will be listed on your course outlines.
- International students: You may have additional factors to consider when choosing your courses.

REGISTER FOR COURSES

TIPS

- XPFT 20001 Human Anatomy and XPFT 20002 Human Physiology are in the Personal Fitness Trainer subject area on MyMRU. You'll need to register for all three linked sections (lecture, lab, tutorial) for your preferred section. Section 002 (online) and 004 (in-person) are restricted for Massage Therapy students.
- Stay informed about add/drop dates, withdrawal dates, and other registration timelines through the Critical Dates Calendar.

Course Delivery Modes



PRACTICUM & OUTREACH (PRC)

Practicum

- Practicum courses are delivered in person at MRU's Student Practicum Clinic.
- Courses are scheduled during daytime, evening and weekend hours.

Outreach

- Outreach courses include on- and off-site practical opportunities with special populations.
- Outreach hours are scheduled during daytime, evenings, and weekends.



ONLINE (ON)

- Instructor-facilitated online courses begin and end on set dates with specific deadlines for assessments.
- There are no specific times or days to attend online lectures. Coursework is completed independently online.
- Final exams are proctored online through ProctorU (fees apply).



BLENDED (BL)

 Combination of scheduled in-person lectures and independent online coursework



LECTURE (LEC)

- In-person lectures are scheduled in a classroom.
- Lecture courses are typically scheduled during daytime, weekday hours.
