ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Must be referred through Persons with Developmental Disability (PDD)
- Expressed desire to study and learn
- Interest in a program of study that has available space. Spots may be limited in specific programs of study due to current student enrollment
- Ability to function independently in a post-secondary environment and abide by the Code of Student Community Standards
