| <b>ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION</b><br>Entrance to honours is competitive—not guaranteed. Grade point average (GPA) will be used to rank qualified applicants according to academic achievement. To be eligible to apply for admission, students must be registered in the Bachelor of Arts and declared a major in the honours discipline. Applicants must present a minimum GPA of 3.00 in the most recent ten 3-credit courses (or equivalent). This GPA is calculated on the basis of whole semesters only. Applicants must submit an unofficial transcript of their complete academic record, at Mount Royal and elsewhere, at the same time as they submit their honours application. Space in the program is limited. For this reason, qualified students are encouraged to apply upon completion of twenty (20) 3-credit courses (or equivalent) toward their program. The success of qualified applicants who have completed thirty or more 3-credit courses will depend on whether additional students can be accommodated within the final year of the program. Such students should make an application prior to the close of the EARLY APPLICATION PERIOD. Pending receipt of final grades for the winter semester, they may be conditionally admitted into the stream before the close of the REGULAR APPLICATION PERIOD. Finally, applicants must identify a research focus that is compatible with faculty available for mentorship within the program. Only tenured or tenurable faculty in English, Film Studies, or Creative Writing with an MA or PhD (or equivalent) are eligible as supervisors. |          |             |          |         |       |        |     |             |                |      |            |
