WHO CAN APPLY?

Applications are welcomed from all students. The recommended preparation is a 1000-level or 2000-level anthropology course.

PROGRAM DATES

In Sri Lanka: May 13 – June 3, 2018

Pre-departure Classes: early May, 2018

Post-Field School Classes: mid-June, 2018

Participants must be available

May 1 - June 13, 2018

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 20, 2017

Apply early. Limited spots remaining. Recruitment is ongoing until openings are filled up. Successful applicants will be notified to proceed with deposit payment.

PROGRAM COSTS

Sri Lanka Field School Program Fees - \$2,995

The Program Fees include: all accommodation in double/triple/dorm rooms, local transportation in Sri Lanka, most meals, bottled water, faculty and assistant expenses, MRU administration fee, honoraria for guest lecturers, activity/entrance fees and gratuities. Fees are payable in person at the Office of the Registrar (A101) according to the payment deadlines outlined in the table below.

1 st deposit*	Upon acceptance / Oct. 27, 2017	\$500
2 nd deposit	November 28, 2017	\$1,250
3 rd deposit	January 19, 2018	\$1,245

*The initial program deposit is non-refundable and secures the participant's place in the program. Program fees do not include course tuition and additional expenses.

MRU TUITION, GENERAL FEES & ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

MRU Tuition and fees for ANTH 2121 (3 credits) are in addition to the Field School program fees above. Students are also responsible for expenses not included in the program fees, such as return airfare to Sri Lanka, travel health insurance, passport, Sri Lankan visitor visa, food not covered in the program fee, travel essentials, personal spending etc. Estimates of additional student costs are available at the Information Session and from the Office of International Education.
