Teacher Check List for MRU Custom Workshops and Clinic (Workshops at MRU):

- Students need:
 - Instruments
 - Music
 - Blank paper for taking notes
 - Water bottle
 - Pencils
 - o Do not let them get on the bus without their required instruments!
- Small Aux Percussion as required by your repertoire
- All drumsticks, mallets, and hammers
- Clinician feedback/info forms pre-filled in to give specific info on director goals, instructions by section and relevant student info
- Extra reeds for all woodwinds
- o Mouthpiece puller for brass instruments
- Small instrument repair kit (screwdriver and contact cement especially!)
- Clinic group assignments (eg. If you have 3 clarinet clinicians, know who belongs in what group before you get off the bus)
- Scores for the Guest Conductor, and an extra score for taking notes during the Guest Conductor session
- Percussion clinicians prefer to have a copy of the scores for clinics
- Copies of all music for clinicians to use during clinics
- Students need to pack a lunch (unless you have alternate plans for catering). Please note there
 is no access to a microwave or disposable cutlery
- Printed copies of the itinerary/facility map for chaperones
- Address expected behavior during transportation on buses/respect for MRU transportation partners
