HREB Scholarly Review

Biomedical and scientific studies submitted to HREB may require a scholarly review. The primary objective of scholarly reviews is determine the level of risk related to proposed methods and interventions based on existing studies on the topic.

Scholarly Review Process

- 1. Applications will undergo a pre-review process (7 business days).
- 2. If the application is incomplete, researchers will be contacted with a request for additional information or clarifications.
- 3. Once the pre-review process is complete the application will be sent for a scholarly review (2 weeks).
- 4. Based on the scholarly review, minimal risk studies will be delegated to HREB reviewers, while above minimal risk studies will be sent for full board review.
- 5. Reviewers have up to two weeks to submit their initial feedback for delegated reviews.
- 6. Researchers conducting above minimum risk studies must submit applications 4 weeks before the full board meeting to allow for the pre-review process and scholarly review.
