Inspection	<p>Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Officer conducted an inspection via telephone on February 18, 2026. The inspection was initiated by OHS in response to a health and safety concern reported to the OHS Contact Centre surrounding the Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC). OHS made contact with the Environmental Health and Safety Manager for the employer who assisted the OHS Officer with the inspection.</p> <p>There is one function JHSC at the work site with 10 members consisting of worker and employer representatives. The committee meets 4-5 times a year. Incident data is shared with the committee and further information can be requested from members if required. No recent dangerous work refusals have been reported - one that was reported was determined not to be an undue hazard for the purposes of Part 3 of the OHS Act. A work stoppage had occurred on the work site and was in relation to a contractor on the work site in the summer of 2025. This was brought up during the committee meeting occurring in fall.</p> <p>There are smaller safety groups for departments to bring like areas together to discuss health and safety related items. These groups can raise concerns to the JHSC if required</p>	February 18, 2026

The *Alberta Occupational Health and Safety Act* requires that orders issued be brought to the attention of all affected workers at the work site as soon as the orders have been received and posted for so long as the orders remain in effect.

Section 45 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* allows for orders and some decisions to be appealed. Visit [Occupational Health and Safety](#) or call 1-866-415-8690 for more information. The initiation of an appeal does not suspend the order or decision unless a stay is granted. Requests for an appeal must be initiated within 30 days of the initial date of service.
