Section 45 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act allows for orders and some decisions to be appealed. Visit <u>Jobs, Economy and Northern Development</u> or call 1-866-415-8690 for more information. The initiation of an appeal does not suspend the order or decision unless a stay is granted. Requests for an appeal must be initiated within 30 days of the initial date of service.
